Our plan was to design an outreach program to bring not only food and library services directly to neighbors in every part of the county, but also to provide resources that have not previously been available or easily accessed. Although supply-chain issues delayed delivery of our van, we didn't let the pandemic stop us from providing much-needed services to the community, leasing a vehicle to fulfill the mission.





The customized van will allow Mobile Comunidad to provide a full range of library services for all ages, including books, DVDs, audiobooks, and technology available to check out.




02. More food distributions
